- Applicants must submit a credit card valid through June 2019, which will be charged \$125 ONLY if the applicant is awarded a scholarship but does not attend the Annual Conference, unless they contact GFOA to withdraw from the program prior to **April 30, 2019** (no penalty for withdrawal).

GFOA charges this no-show fee to discourage anyone from taking up one of the 50 spots allotted for their state/province if they do not intend to attend the Annual Conference. If you need to cancel for any reason, please contact us so we can offer your scholarship to an applicant on the waitlist.



BENEFITS

- The scholarship covers the full conference registration fee. All scholarship recipients are responsible for their travel and lodging. The scholarship does not include registration for preconference seminars held before the start of the Annual Conference.
- Scholarship recipients will participate in GFOA's mentorship program during the Annual Conference as an introduction to the event and also the many ways to become more involved with GFOA.

As a mentee, you and a small group of other scholarship recipients will be paired with an experienced GFOA member leading up to the Annual Conference.
